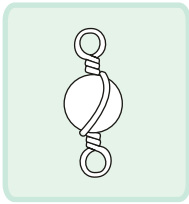


Lesson 07: How to make a wrapped bead



Materials:

Wire
beads

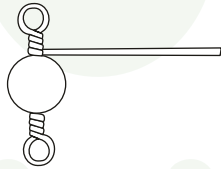
Tools:

Wire cutters
Round Nose pliers
Flat-nose Pliers

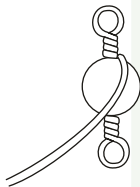
- 1 Make one wrapped loop as seen on Lesson 3.



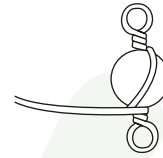
- 2 Slip on your bead and make another wrapped loop on the other end of the bead. Just as before, wrap the wire around itself. However, don't cut the wire.



- 3 Use the left over wire and bring it down around the bead.



- 4 Wrap the wire back around the wire at the bottom of the bead.



- 5 Trip off excess wire, and file the ends of the wire as necessary. ★



Designer's Tip!

This versatile technique can be used for making bracelets, necklaces, or even earrings. To make a chain you will have to connect the loops before you close them. To do this, after you have one complete loop, put the tail of the wire on the second loop through one of the finished ends of the first completed link.
